MG Trust Grower Education Fund

The MG Grower Trust Education Fund aligns with the MG Trust's objective to advance the education of people within the horticulture industry.

Rabobank Farm Managers Programme

The programme is an opportunity to learn from experts and network with leading growers and farmers. It aims to further develop management and leadership skills; improve your communication, time management; learn how to develop a business plan; and understand the essentials of financial management and budgeting.

Attendees are required to have at least three years' experience.

The course cost is \$5,650.00. Applicants who secure a \$5000.00 subsidy are required to pay the balance and cover travel to and from Christchurch. All other costs are covered, including accommodation, meals and transfers.

The programme helps build strategic planning capabilities and commercial management skills to explore options for business growth. Growers leave the programme inspired by farming and business experts, and with access to a new network of progressive farmers.
